Making access fairer

We've made improvements to the way we place students in <u>opportunity</u> classes and selective high schools.

The Equity Placement Model helps to make access fairer by holding a percentage of places for students from the following under-represented groups:

- low socio-educational advantage students
- Aboriginal students
- rural and remote students
- students with disability

We know that students from these groups are missing out due to experiencing unintended barriers, such as educational disadvantage.

Our new placement processes will help ensure more students have fair and equitable opportunities to reach their full potential.
