Fire Incident on Monday 16th Sept, an electrical contractor had a workplace accident. They suffer burns but is ok. Safework was engaged to investigate.

The resultant surge of energy knocked out electricity to school and surrounding area. Power was restored around 4pm.

The surge of power could be felt in the carpark and office. There was a little bit of fire damage to the roof of the room and switchboard has melted. Main damage was to cables, the full hall may require re-cabling and possibly other areas of the school.

Repair cost is about \$2-300,000 and will take months to fix. The work will go to tender. Trying to get a generator to power the for hall for HCS and the canteen.
